Burns Philp and Company Ltd

The archives holds several deposits of material from Burns Philp, which includes their activities in the New Hebrides (Vanuatu). Burns Philp was a major shipping line and acted as merchants and agents in the Pacific Islands, as well as providing a mail service and carrying tourists to various Pacific destinations, including Vanuatu. After 1904, Burns Philp also began to acquire land to develop into plantations in the Pacific region.

Materials in the Burns Philp archives range from correspondence and financial documents, legal and land transactions, photographs and promotional materials.

<u>Z385</u>	Burns Philp and Company holding deposit	All types of company records including minutes, correspondence, reports, legal and financial records, staff records, investment registers, branch returns, subject files, strategic plans, photographs, plans, videotapes and audiotapes of interviews with company executives. Includes records of head office, branches and subsidiaries and associated companies such as Mauri Brothers and Thomson. This deposit includes many cartons which are not yet processed and listed.
